International Reenactment Market IRM2022 “light” – 23.-24.04.2022

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

I would like to introduce to you a new event to be held at the **RömerWelt Museum in Rheinbrohl** (Germany).

This event is a follow-up of a well-established series of events formerly presented by the Archaeological Park Roman Villa Borg (IRM2011-IRM2018). Since the administration at Borg/Merzig refused to continue this series of events, I had to find a new suitable location. The **RömerWelt Museum in Rheinbrohl**, located between Bonn and Koblenz, now fills this gap, starting with the **International Reenactment Market IRM2022 on April 23rd to 24th, 2022**.

The IRM2022 will again be open to all epochs ranging from Stone Age until 19th Century.

Due to the current corona-prevention the IRM2022 will be held in as a “light” version with reduced amount of traders and visitors as well. Please assure that you as a trader meet the “2G-requirement”, meaning that you either recently recovered from the COVID-19-disease or are vaccinated.

The IRM is the first successful attempt to create and establish a reenactor’s market event in Germany, which mainly presents high quality reproductions for museums and reenactors. All contact informations of the participants (traders / craftsmen) will be available online on the IRM-website for a long period of time after the event in order to enable better research for potential customers.
