I would like to introduce to you a new event to be held at the **RömerWelt Museum in Rheinbrohl** (Germany).

This event is a follow-up of a well-established series of events formerly presented by the Archaeological Park Roman Villa Borg (IRM2011-IRM2018). Since the administration at Borg/Merzig refused to continue this series of events, I had to find a new suitable location. The **RömerWelt Museum in Rheinbrohl**, located between Bonn and Koblenz, successfully fills this gap since 2022.

The IRM2023 will again be open to all epochs ranging from Stone Age until 19th Century.

The IRM is the first successful attempt to create and establish a reenactor's market event in Germany, which mainly presents high quality reproductions for museums and reenactors.
